WHERE IS THE RACE?

All the fun happens in Bridgton, Maine. The race begins at Food City grocery store at the corner of Route 302 and S. Main Street. The starting gun goes off promptly at 8:00 am, and the race finishes in front of the The Old Memorial School at the turn on Depot Street. There are water stations at each mile marker along the race course. There is water and Gatorade along with watermelon for racers at the finish line. If a runner requires medical assistance, it is available. Race times are recorded and available for each runner at the finish line.
